

This little e-book seems like an article in which I felt that the author, himself, doesn't know much about Kanban for software development. There are much better articles on Kanban available freely on Blogs. The Kanban method for IT was formulated by David Anderson and was pained to see not a single reference about him in this book as well. his book doesn't take into account the practices of Kanban and not sure how it can be referred as a guide, as the title suggests. Even if it is available for free, I won't suggest it to anybody and would ask them to join related groups on Kanban in Yahoo and LinkedIn.

I read this book because one of my family members works in the software commercial industry and I

wanted to see what their approach to product development is like. I understand the basics of Agile, but I never heard of anything called Kanban. From reading this book, I can infer that Kanban is an additional process framework on top of Agile. Kanban focuses more on incremental development - improving products from one iteration to the next. The book does do a good job explaining the differences, but I still have some difficulties picturing some of things that the book talks about. Still a good book though.

This book introduced me to the Kanban system and how it is able to contribute to a business system's efficiency. Interesting insights. Author was able to lay out a solid foundation of its basic principles through specific examples and scenarios. A recommended tool for project managers!
