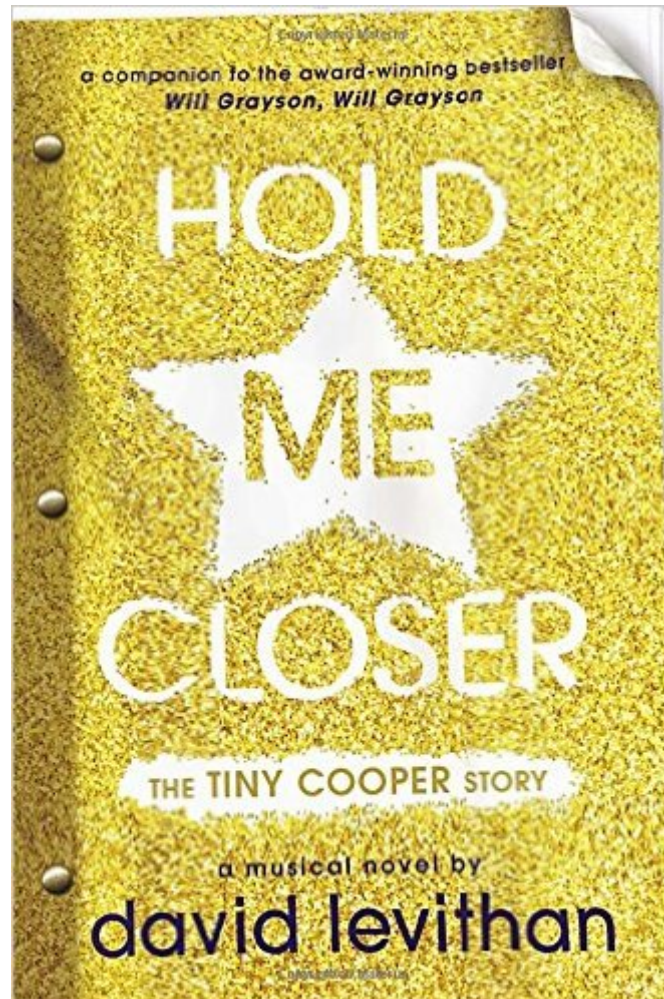

I'd rate this 4.5 stars. *Will Grayson, Will Grayson*, by John Green and David Levithan, was one of the best books I read in 2010, and years later, it remains one of my favorites. That book, populated by two very different high school students, both named Will Grayson. One Will Grayson's best friend, "Tiny" Cooper, who isn't shy about his size or his sexuality, and tries to push Will to declare his

feelings for his best friend, Jane, all while Tiny is getting ready to produce his autobiographical musical. This "companion piece," authored by Levithan, is the script of Tiny's musical, complete with his commentary/stage direction, which in some cases, lets the reader in on how the lives of both Will Graysons, Jane, and Tiny progressed after the book ends. But mostly, the musical gives tremendous insight into what it's like to live a life where everyone thinks they know who and what you are, and just how much courage it takes to put yourself so far out there and be happy with who you are every day.
