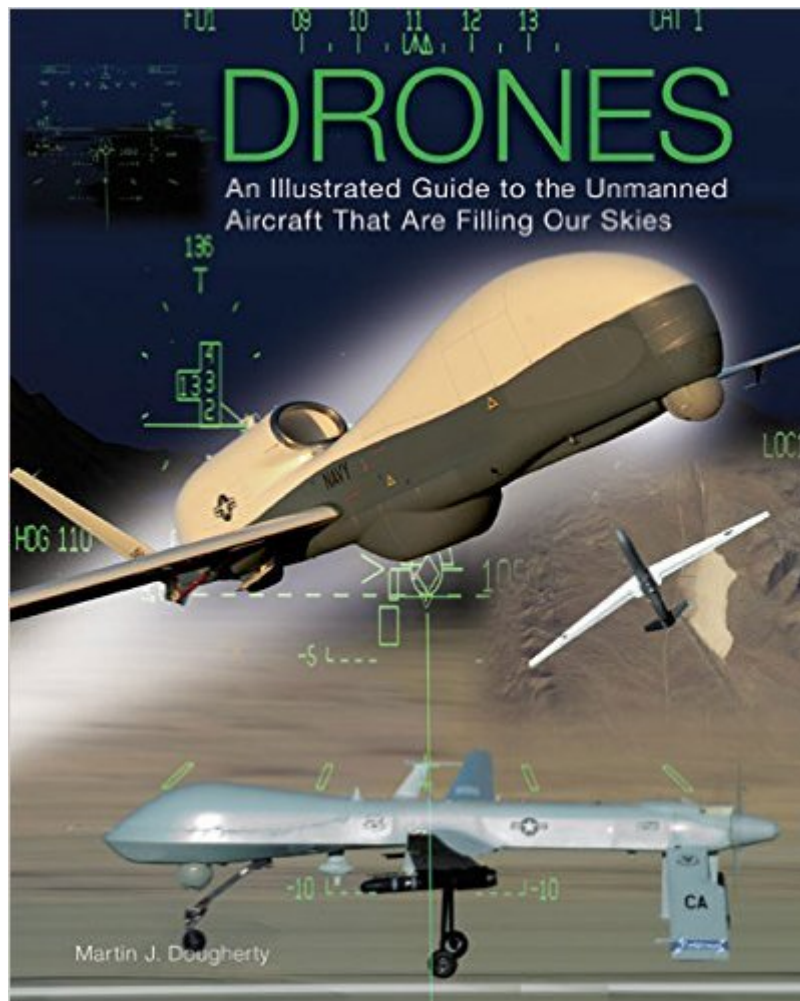

This is the first really thorough history of remotely piloted vehicles I've seen. It's beautifully

illustrated, has tremendous technical detail, and will be a fine addition to anyone who follows the history and technology of aerospace power. A fine addition to your personal library.

This book is pretty concise in covering numerous unmanned aerial vehicles --- as a matter of fact, it is the first non-technical book to include the X-37B military spaceplane, RQ-170 Sentinel, and X-51 hypersonic air-breathing research aircraft. I like how the author provides diagrams of how our country's most formidable UAVs operate, and he even provides a bar graph showing how many people have been killed by US drone strikes in Yemen and Pakistan because drone strikes have been criticized as extrajudicial and represent a case study in the logic of just war (that is, you use military action wisely to avoid killing innocent civilians). If anyone is interested in unmanned air vehicles, this book is an outstanding must-read.
