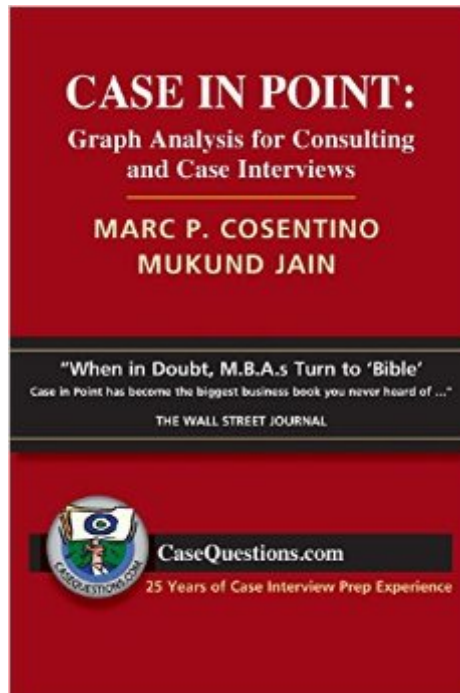

Quite useful for non-scientists who want to hone their graph-reading skills. It's nice to have all the different types of graphs in one place, but it doesn't contain any radically new info that isn't online somewhere. There are several typos throughout, which are, at best, annoying, and at worst, make one of the example cases unusable. In that case, each column on the bar chart is exactly the same, even though the written analysis suggests they are different. Hopefully the second edition will fix these errors but I feel like this edition was rushed out carelessly.

Analysis of graphs is one of the core elements of consulting interviews. It's important to interpret data accurately, but it is even more important to understand the full story behind the graph and get to the "so-what" quickly. This book focuses on helping you master this core aspect of with a solid framework and a nice selection of graphs. The 8 cases are really good, too, providing good practice

on graph interpretation. I would highly recommend it to anyone interested in management consulting
