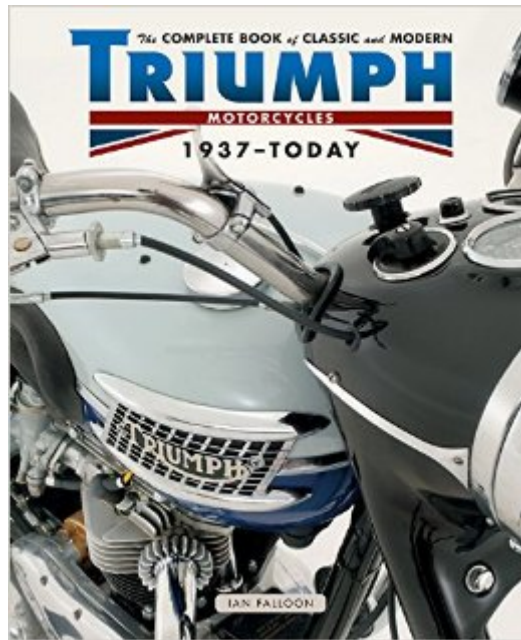

The Triumph works at Priory Street, Coventry, in 1915. Most of these are Model Hs for war duties. 57,000 Model Hs were produced between 1915 and 1923. The Ricardo was the first

overhead-valve Triumph. Not renowned for its excellent handling, the Model H chassis was tested by the more powerful fourvalve engine. The wheels were 26 inches front and rear and the braking rudimentary. In production form it weighed 250 pounds. Edward Turner, never shy of publicity, appears here with a Speed Twin, posing for publicity photos with actress Rita Hayworth at Columbia Pictures in 1947.

Extremely purposeful and good looking, the 1951 T100 Tiger. Craig Vetter's X75 Hurricane was the first factory custom sports bike, and one of the most successful.
