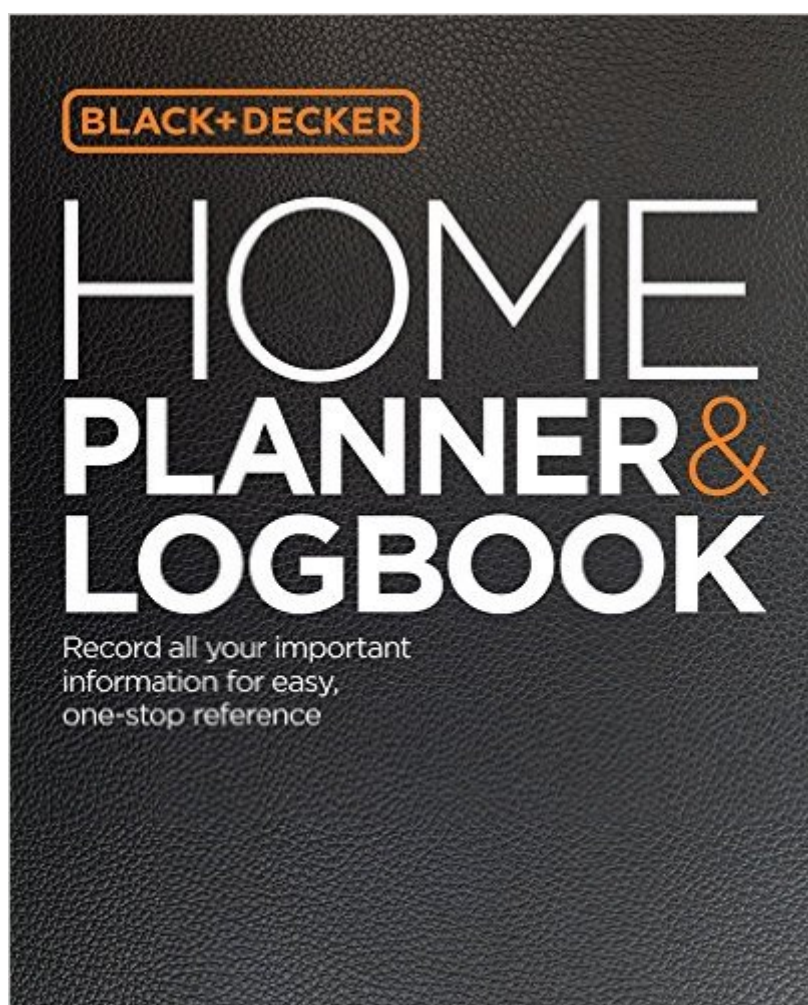

numbers, phone numbers for merchandisers, serial numbers of your products, etc. It gives you lists after lists. If you are an organizer or want to become one, this will be the ONLY book you will ever need again. I still have not been able to complete my household belongings because it is so extensive. It will also be great when you make new household purchases...all you need to do is put down all the pertinent information and you have it for safekeeping. I would suggest that once you start filling in the pages, you keep it in a fire-proof box. It is sure to help you if you ever have a disaster in your home. Insurance purposes aside, this is a great way to catalog your belongings that are precious to you.

In the first few years we did so many updates to the home like the furnace, water pump, water filtration, hot water heater and more. In September our water pump went and we knew we had replaced it when we moved in but it would have been nice to be able to check back, see what the issue was and have all the information we needed. Since we didn't my husband had to pull the pump up with my assistance (gross nasty job) to get the measurements so we could go pick one up. It only took 2 days but it was annoying nonetheless. I recommend this book to every homeowner to keep track of everything in one spot. There is even pockets for you to include receipts and manuals so you never lose them. A-M and N-Z so you don't have to search through everything. From your roof to your driveway, your windows to your dryer it is all in here. Great investment in your home and a great first home gift.

Wish I had something like this years ago! This is a great replacement for the manila envelopes/file folders/three-ring binder system that has never really worked well over the years. The home planner/logbook might finally end the "when did I replace that...?" question I seem to be asking about various things in my home. This basically covers every part of your home, inside and out, enabling you to keep track of what you did and when in every room and area of your home. There's info and maintenance logs for virtually everything - appliances, flooring, doors, windows, siding, roof, and more. There's also a home inventory log where you can write down the make, model, size & style, age and cost of tons of items - furniture, tools, jewelry, musical instruments, clothing, valuables, etc. Another great feature is the info and advice about key parts of your home - wiring, hvac, foundation, siding - with home improvement basics and things to look out for. With the amount of info available, and everything you can keep track of, it might seem a bit like overkill - but it really isn't. Everything is laid out in a logical fashion; my only gripe is that you could easily run out of

space in the boxes in the inventory logs if you're not careful. Finally, the cover material is really smart - it's rubber/vinyl and seems like it will be very durable for all the years you'll probably be using it. This is a must for any homeowner - whether you're a bit OCD with your record-keeping or haphazard. I think this could also be a great thing to leave behind for the next person/family who buys your house. I wish I had an easy-to-access detailed history of what was done and when, instead of going back to the disclosure form.

There is valuable information about basic household functions and the records pages serve as good reminders for information to keep. However I have had a difficult time making the format meet my needs. I will go back to my old 3-hole notebook. I will keep better information as a benefit of having this book.

I saw this advertised and was originally getting one for a co-worker. After checking into it I got two more for my married children. It is particularly good for new homeowners but anyone with a house would love it.

This book is the answer to an organizer's dreams. It enables you to keep track of when items were replaced or installed. Also keeps track of paint colors, etc. A must for new homeowners (great housewarming gift). A real blessing when you go to sell. Highly recommend!
