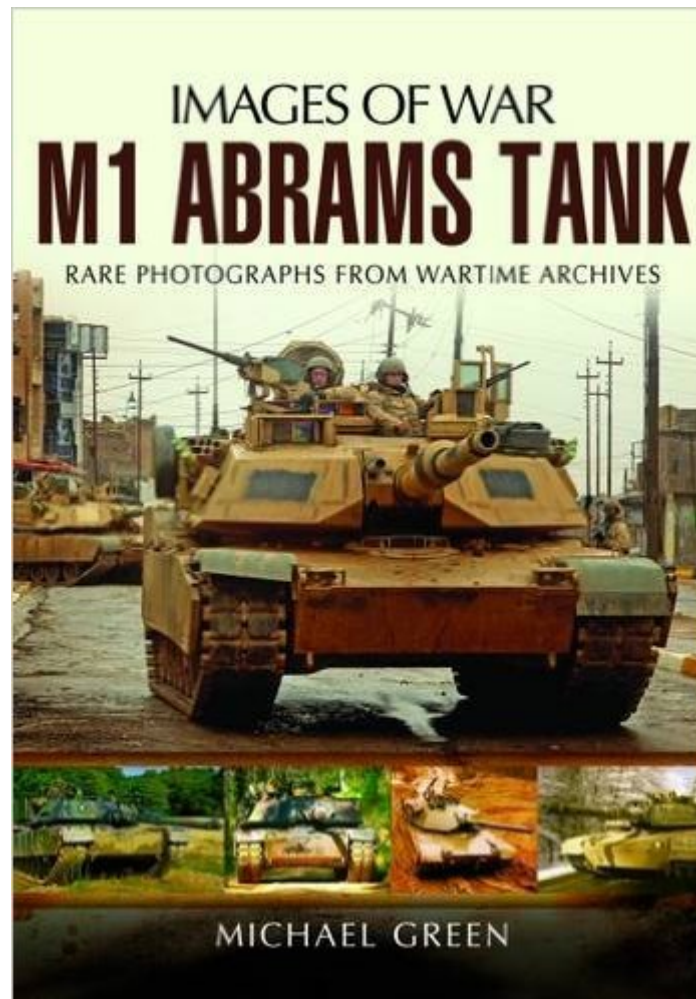

The M1 Abrams has proved itself to be the finest main battle tank in the World since its introduction into US Army service in 1981. It routed the Soviet equipment of Saddam Hussein's army and today remains the yardstick by which friends' and foes' MBTs are judged. Its versatility and continual modernization of weaponry, armor and engineering guarantees that the M1 Abrams will remain the US Army's spearpoint for years to come. Expert author Michael Green has produced a comprehensive collection of images and highly informed text. REVIEWS there are some impressive photographs, all have been chosen to tell the story, not just to entertain. Mr Green's text describes the history and service of the Abrams in a readable and accessible style. The book is neither anoracky at one end of the scale or too generic at the other. I think I commented that one of his last books on tanks may have been out of place in the Images of War range and could have been an expanded and glossier history in its own right. I may have missed the point. Having a book of this quality in this range makes it affordable on one level and it adds a strong degree of credibility to the series on the other War History Online
