

I took this book on a recent family road trip from Cincinnati, OH to the Grand Canyon. We stayed in, or stopped at several lodgings listed in the book and also ate at several of the restaurants. The book was easy to follow, since it broke Route 66 into sections, then listed lodging, followed by dining in each section. Each restaurant or hotel/motel, etc. had a picture and a quick summary of cost range and what they offered, which was helpful to us in making selections on where to eat and stay. This book is up to date and reliable. One suggestion I would make for the next addition is to include the zip code for each establishment, which would make it a bit easier to run directions for GPS users.

Looks very complete, and should help us avoid "pot luck" for eating and lodging on our upcoming Route 66 road trip. I like the way they list certain spots that they recommend for their own sightseeing value, whether you dine/lodge there or not. Spiral binder makes it easy to keep it open

to the pages you need as you progress from Chicago to L.A.

As big a believer as I am about buying used and recycling books, I will recommend that you buy the latest version of this one. That said, buy this book. Everywhere you go it will act as a starting point/beginning reference for many parts of your adventure. Well written and concise, well worth the investment to make your time on the Mother Road as enjoyable as possible.
