

I know Jack Cashill, as a gifted writer and as a person of great character in a world that no longer embraces truth tellers. He is a "participant observer", a person who lives amongst us while carefully reflecting on the no longer subtle changes in our mores right down to the very words we are now allowed to use or thoughts we are allowed to think. Everything he writes is done with substantial analysis in terms of his own self reflection and life experience as well as in the observations of esteemed others of expressed thought and opinion.
